What will the children be doing at school?

- Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum is from birth to five so we continue their learning from home and pre-school.
- Your child will be learning skills, acquiring new knowledge and demonstrating their understanding through 7 areas of learning and development:
 - Communication and Language
 - Physical Development
 - Personal, Social and Emotional Development
 - Literacy
 - Mathematics
 - Understanding of the World
 - Expressive Arts and Design



A typical day in EYFS

- Working from the children's interestswe create purposeful and meaningful experiences in the classroom
- Literacy and Maths sessions
- Daily phonics and reading
- Focus is on developing children's knowledge, understanding and skills through play and experience
- We take into account every child's needs and interests and we are highly skilled at recognising and implementing next steps of learning




Keeping your children safe
